2. WORK EXPERIENCE

He graduated from the Hellenic Naval Academy in 1997 as an Ensign and has since specialized in military electronic and combat systems. He has held staff and commanding positions across various naval commands, and his operational service includes deployment at sea on board several surface ships (mainly frigates and gunboats). In the last four years of his career, he served initially as Head of the Naval Operations Department at the National Joint Operations Center, under the Hellenic National Defence General Staff (HNDGS) and then as Assistant Lead Coordinator for Current Joint Operations, in the same institution. On 2nd January 2026 he submitted his application for retirement from the Hellenic Navy and on the 15th May 2026 he promoted on the rank of Commodore HN (Ret).

He has also completed various military and naval training programs appropriate to his rank, including the "Compat Information Center Watch Officer Course" at the Surface Warfare Officers School Command in Rhode Island, USA, the Tacticos Primary Operator Course at THALES in the Netherlands and the Hellenic Naval Command and Staff College (HNCSC).

He has graduated from the Department of Naval Architecture at the School of Engineering, University of West Attica, and holds an MSc in Military Electronic Systems Engineering from Cranfield University in the United Kingdom (sponsored by Hellenic Navy upon seating exams). He also attends part time the Westlawn Yacht Design and Naval Architecture program (USA). He is currently studying the Msc in Ship Performance Analysis and Management, at the National Technical University of Athens.
